**Johanna Batista of Seville, Spain** will be giving a **Classical Riding Clinic** at the **Post Falls Equestrian Center**. The event is being organized by Trainer Karen Adam of Prairie Performance and Dressage. Classical equitation is the philosophy of understanding the horse and the precision of aids given with the horse's natural movements, to achieve lightness, elegance and harmony through understanding of precise aids and a sympathetic awareness of the horse.

Johanna began competition riding in 1965 with her own pony in Bangkok (Thailand), entering gymkhanas and show jumping, moving on into show jumping and 3-day events at Junior interschool teams from 1969-1975 in Kent (U.K.). Also during this time she competed in show jumping at the national level for juniors in Tangier (Morocco) on mostly Barb horses.

From 1977 on through 2000, she has taken many courses from some of the world's most renowned classical riding masters in Spain, Portugal, France, the U.K. and Morocco. She has ridden Lusitanos, Arab/Barb crosses, Andalusians and worked with Daniel Feher at the Spanish Riding School in Vienna, Austria. **She was a student of the Royal School in Jerez, Spain and graduated from the Cadre Noir at Samur, France where she worked with renowned trainers Nuno Oliveria and Michael Henriquet.** Throughout the years she has advanced to the highest level of dressage and people now travel from all over the world to her Hacienda Dos Olivos ([www.haciendadosolivos.es](http://www.haciendadosolivos.es)) in Seville, Spain to take lessons on her high school trained Andalusian Stallions and receive instruction in absolute classical methods of riding.

**From Training Level thru Grand Prix**, here is your opportunity to experience an event which is very rare here in North Central Idaho/Eastern Washington.
