Fees:

Open Breed Show: \$8 /class if postmarked on or before August 1; \$12/class after August 1.

Sweepstakes Classes: Entry fee \$20, no exceptions.

You must enter by the beginning of the prior session, no entries after session has begun.

Office fee per horse: \$10/horse

Haul in fee of \$35 will be charged for horses not having box stalls.

Stall rental is \$35/day or \$85 for 3pm Friday thru 5pm Sunday. Indicate preference on entry form.

Class Specifications:

English Pleasure Division

To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter (limited to walk and trot in the walk/trot classes). Horses will enter the arena in a counter-clockwise direction at the trot. Riders will reverse toward the inside of the arena. Riders may be asked to back up on the rail or in the line-up at the end of the class. Except in the walk/trot classes, riders may be asked to extend at any gait.

Required tack:

English-style saddle (dressage, hunt seat, or saddle seat) and bridle. Bridle shall be light, show type; either snaffle, pelham, full bridle or kimberwicke bit, acceptable. Browbands/ cavessons must be of hunter type.. Riders must wear English-style boots; a hunt cap, English riding helmet, or English derby; long-sleeved shirt; and a hunt /dressage / saddle seat coat. . Spurs, whip or crop optional

Class is judged on horse's way of going, manners, obedience, and suitability as a pleasure mount.

English Sweepstakes: To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter and hand gallop both ways of the ring. Horses will enter the arena in a counter-clockwise direction at the trot. Riders may be asked to back up on the rail or in the line-up at the end of the class. Required tack: English-style saddle (dressage, hunt seat, or saddle seat) and bridle. Figure-8 nose bands are not permitted. Riders must wear English-style boots; a hunt cap, English riding helmet, or English derby; long-sleeved shirt; and a hunt /dressage / saddle seat coat. Spurs and whip or crop are optional.

Half of the entry fees collected for this class will be awarded as prize money, with 50% for 1st, 30% for 2nd, 15% for 3rd and 5% for fourth place.

Advanced English Pleasure: To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter and hand gallop both ways of the ring. Horses will enter the arena in a counter-clockwise direction at the trot and then proceed at the direction of the judge. Extended gaits may be requested. Advanced moves such as extended gaits, counter leads, side-passing and turns over the forehand and haunches may be requested by the judge.

Show Hack; To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop, collected, extended and normal gaits to be called for; to stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on manners, performance, quality. The Show Hack is a suitable section for the well trained animal.

A Show Hack horse entry shall be able to perform all of these gaits with a noticeable transition between the normal, collected, and extended gaits. The horse must be under complete control and easily ridden. Obedience to the rider is of prime importance.

If the horse exhibits clear transitions in a balanced and level manner, appearing to be giving a comfortable and pleasurable ride, he is performing correctly for this class.

Required tack: Hunt seat or dressage saddle and bridle, Riders must wear Hunt style attire, boots, derby or helmet is mandatory

English Equitation Division; Riders to show and be judged at a walk, trot and canter. Except in the walk/trot classes, riders may be asked to extend at any gait. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse to rider and suitability of horse to rider. Required tack: English-style saddle (dressage, hunt seat, or saddle seat. Riders must wear English style attire, English

style helmet, or English derby, and a hunt/dressage/saddle seat coat. Riders are allowed whips and spurs. Rail class, pattern at Judge's discretion.

Western Pleasure Division

To be shown at the walk, jog, and lope (limited to walk and jog in the walk/trot classes). Horses will enter the arena in a counter-clockwise direction at the jog. Riders will reverse toward the inside of the arena. In Junior Horse classes, riders are permitted to use two hands on the reins if they are using a snaffle bit. Riders may be asked to back up on the rail or in the line-up at the end of the class. Required tack: western saddle and bridle. Riders must hold the reins in one hand throughout the class; touching the reins with the second hand or inserting a finger between the Rommel reins are grounds for disqualification. In Junior Horse classes, riders are permitted to use two hands on the reins if they are using a snaffle bit. Riders must wear western-style boots, hat, chaps, and a long-sleeved shirt. Spurs are optional.

Class is judged on horse's way of going, manners, obedience, and suitability as a pleasure mount.

Advanced Western Pleasure: To be shown at the walk, jog, lope and hand gallop both ways of the ring. Advanced moves such as extended gaits, counter leads, rollbacks, side-passing and turns over the forehand and haunches may be requested by the judge. Horses will enter the arena in a counter-clockwise direction at the jog and perform required tasks at the discretion of the judge from that point.

Western Sweepstakes Class: To be shown at the walk, jog, lope, and hand gallop. Horses will enter the arena in a counter-clockwise direction at the jog. Riders may be asked to back up on the rail or in the line-up at the end of the class. Extended gaits may be requested by the judge. Required tack: western saddle and bridle. Riders must hold the reins in one hand throughout the class; touching the reins with the second hand or inserting a finger between the Rommel reins are grounds for disqualification. If riding a junior horse, riders are permitted to use two hands on the reins if they are using a snaffle bit. Riders must wear western-style boots, hat, chaps, and a long-sleeved shirt. Belts are required. Spurs are optional.

Half of the entry fees collected for this class will be awarded as prize money, with 50% for 1st, 30% for 2nd, 15% for 3rd, and 5% for fourth place.

Western Equitation Division: Riders to show and be judged at a flat-footed 4 beat walk, 2 beat jog-trot and a 3 beat lope both ways of the ring, back in a straight line during the lineup. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse to rider and suitability of horse to rider. Required tack: Western saddle and bridle. Riders must hold the reins in one hand throughout the class unless the horse is a junior horse being appropriately shown in a bosel or snaffle bit with two hands permitted. Touching the reins with the second hand or inserting a finger between the Rommel reins are grounds for disqualification. Riders must wear western-style boots, hat, and a long-sleeved shirt. Spurs are optional. Chaps are not permitted. Rail class, pattern at Judge's discretion.

Definitions

Junior Horse: Horse must be 5 years old or younger.

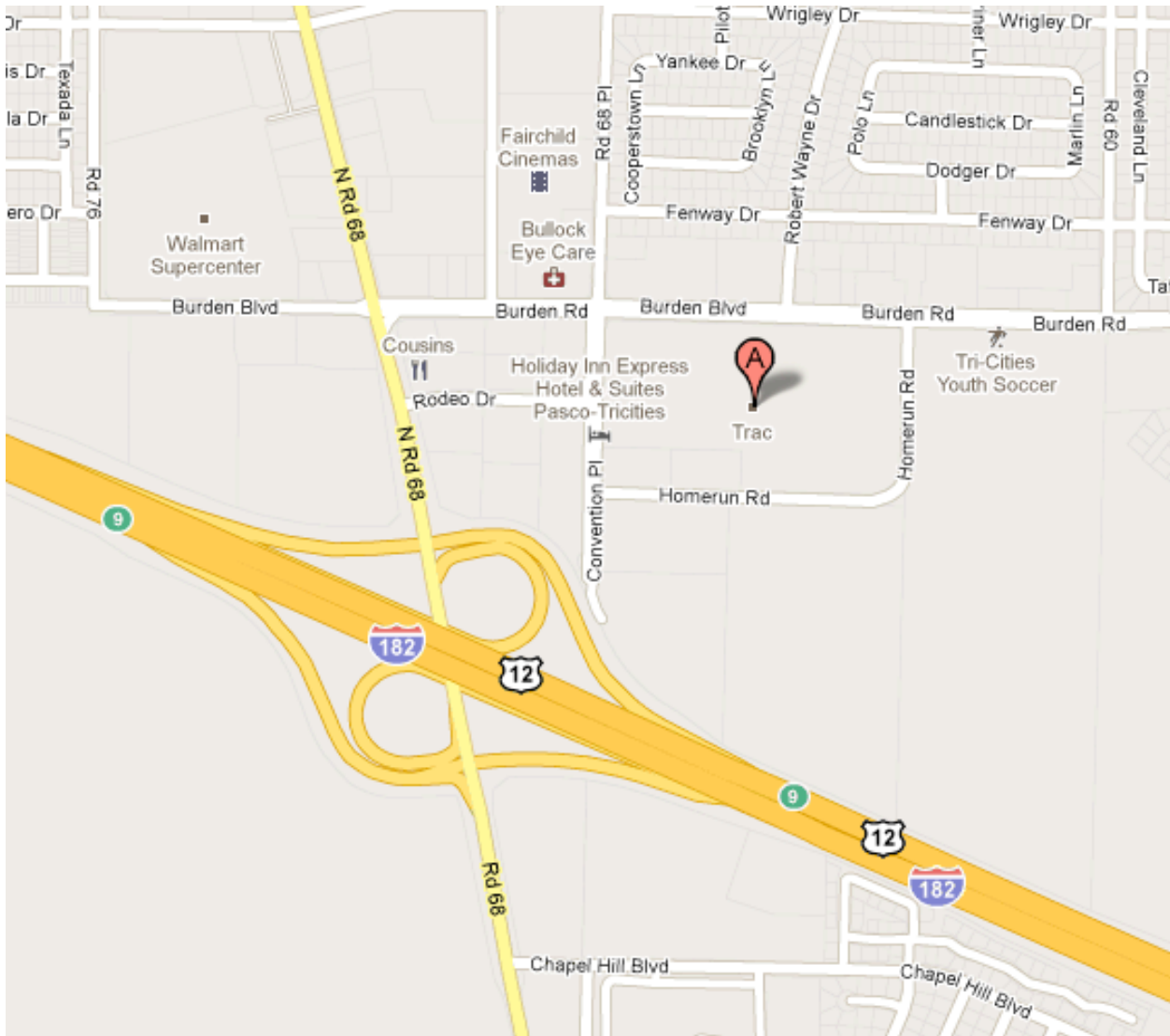
Senior Horse: Horse is 6 years old or older.

Junior Exhibitor: Rider must not have attained the age of 18 prior to January 1, 2010.

Senior Exhibitor: Riders who have attained the age of 18 prior to January 1, 2010.

Sweepstakes: Sweepstakes classes shall have a pay-back purse of half of the entry fees collected for the class, with 50% for 1st, 30% for 2nd, 15% for 3rd and 5% for 4th placing.

Entry Agreement

By entering this competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Rider or Handler and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree to comply with the local rules of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Judge, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken at the competition. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the class specifications, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the competition may use or assign photographs or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition (*Festival of the Andalusian*) to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”).

I AGREE to release the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Competition strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child’s behalf.

I AGREE that the “Competition” as used above includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition. **BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE** to be bound by all terms and provisions of this entry blank.
